SUBJECT: Air Force Reserve Officer Training Corps (AFROTC) Active Student Requirements

1. Welcome to Texas A&M and AFROTC Detachment 805. All incoming cadets are required to bring the following items to Freshmen Orientation Week on 16 August 2017:
  - a. Full-size original Birth Certificate (or Naturalization Certificate) and one copy
  - b. Original Social Security Card with student's signature and one copy
  - c. A voided check or E-deposit Slip (account must be in cadet's name)
  - d. A completed AFROTC Form 28 signed by a Medical Doctor (to include MD stamp), **which is different than Corps of Cadets' required medical form**
  - e. A Selective Service Number Printout (18+ Males only)

2. Cadets who fail to bring the above documents will be classified as Special Students and will not be eligible for the following:
  - a. Monetary entitlements, if applicable
  - b. Nomination for any Selection Program (Scholarships, Field Training Allocation, etc.)
  - c. Participation in Leadership Laboratory (LLAB)
3. To receive the \$800 Military Uniform Commutation, you must satisfy the following:
  - a. All requirements in paragraph 1
  - b. Pass the AFROTC Physical Fitness Assessment in Fall 2017
  - c. Receive at least a "C" in Air Force Class, a "Satisfactory" in LLAB, and earn a Fall 2017 TGPA  $\geq 2.5$
